Archiving mail

- Why would you want to?
- Do you keep a journal?
- Would you ever want to go back and see what you wrote and be amused at your youthful musings?
- Do you want reference old projects?
- Do you want a consolidated archive of all of your email from disparate sources?
- Do you want to preserve your digital legacy?

How?

- Leave all in apple mail or your email client of choice
- Only save those that are important or significant
- Save all attachments manually
- Use an external email archiver app

Email Archiver Pro

- Email Archiver Pro works with Apple's Mail for OS X
- It makes them compatible anywhere you can open up a PDF
- Emails are stored hierarchically in the same way that your email is organized in Mail.app.
- PDFs created have the full email header embedded into the PDF for searching
- All attachments that are displayed online, such as photos, are displayed in the PDF
- Attached files are stored as well
- PDFs use the subject line and the message ID to create a unique, readable file name
- Subsequent scans with Email Archiver only add new emails

MailSteward

- Archives all of your email in a relational database for easy retrieval.
- MailSteward has a wealth of features for importing, tagging, saving, and exporting, including the ability to export your vital email information to a number of standard data formats.
- Easily access your email database with fast, sophisticated searching.
- Protect your precious email data from data format obsolescence.
- You can export mbox files from Microsoft Entourage, Eudora, or other email clients

Mail Archiver X

- Creates a smart archive (Database) taking only what you have not archived before.
- All major email clients are supported: Apple Mail, Eudora, Gmail, Exchange, Outlook, Entourage, Powermail, Postbox, and Thunderbird.
- Speed up your email client by removing the mails from the mail client.
- Flexible export formats: Easily export your email to Evernote, PDF, Filemaker, or other formats to suit your needs.
