MUGOO Digital Asset Protection

How did MUGOO start out (digitally)?

- Well, first of all, it was the NCMC back then, but I digress ...
- You attended meetings in person and possibly bought diskettes that had shareware on them ...
- You dialed up the NCMC's private BBS and exchanged messages there.
 - o This tied up your phone line
 - Long distance charges made it expensive to use non-local BBSes
- Then the Internet happened
 - Distance disappeared
 - The world was your oyster

How do you find someone/something on the internet?

- Places that you want to go still have the equivalent of a phone number
 - An Internet Protocol or IP address
 - An IP4 address looks like 192.168.123.123
- Where is the phone book that has the NCMC's IP address?
 - o The Domain Name System (DNS) is like a decentralized phone book
 - o Today, MUGOO.COM maps to 167.114.83.239
 - o But so do 5201 other domains
 - Sending you to the right site requires black magic

How to get a web presence ...

- Decide on your Top Level Domain (TLD) such as .ca or .com or .christmas
- Prefix the TLD with whatever you want that is not already taken (merry.christmas is still available)
- You need to pay an approved REGISTRAR to reserve the domain name
- You need to pay a HOST to provide access to server hardware and software
 - Most sites use just a tiny slice of a large server
 - Your HOST may handle both your website and email
 - Other software like mailing lists, message boards, etc. may run on the same host
- MUGOO has 2 domains: mugoo.com and mugoo.ca
 - The REGISTRAR was EasyDNS for many many years
 - o The REGISTRANT was Neil for the same period of time
 - The site was HOSTed at Neil's office
 - o The software was Apache, PHP, MySQL, PmWiki, SMF, and SurgeMail with Dlist
 - This presented MANY single points of failure
 - The 9-day power failure after the Derecho exposed most of them

How to *keep* a web presence ...

- All of MUGOO's digital assets have been moved to a shared hosting account at Web Hosting Canada (WHC)
- Wally and David have full admin access to the WHC account
- The domain registrations have been moved to WHC with:
 - Wally as REGISTRANT
 - o David as Admin
 - Neil as Tech
 - This simplifies future changes

Why WHC?

- Based in Montreal
- Uses OVH infrastructure (massive French datacenter company)
- 100% green hydro power located near Beauharnais hydro plant
- Incremental backups every night
- Super cheap intro offer for first 3 years
- We extended the domain registrations to 3 years

Why not WHC?

- Initial server (Decarie) ran into problems and had to be replaced
- WHC rebuilt and restarted Decarie on better hardware
- The "better" hardware ran into problems and they switched us to another server (Verdun)
- The Verdun server reinstall broke many parts of the site for 2 to 3 days
- However ... third time lucky. All seems fine now

But back on the good side ...

- WHC support is good to excellent depending on the agent
- Support is 24/7 on both phone and online chat
- For more technical issues, a ticketing system is used
- Full records of all emails, tickets, invoices, etc. are available online
