Long Press to more easily bring up options

Require Face ID if you want your browsing history to be discrete

Show Reading List to find an article that you had set aside to read

Show Bookmarks to quickly access your favourites

New Tab to open another private or standard tab window

Tap at Top to get to the top of a page

Pause at 2:36 for discussion

Show Reader View only works for some pages

From here you can change page colour and font size, and *Listen to Page*

You can also click *Translate to English*, which is not perfect but better

Hide Distracting Items in your page view, which will reappear with reload

Pause at 8:40 for discussion

Long Press on a link for a Preview

Split View is specific to iPad

Copy Subject works well for people and pets

In Safari settings set DuckDuckGo as your default search engine rather than Google

You can find words on a page in iOS using the **Share Search Page** option

Pause at 15:18 for discussion

Long Press to download a linked file, saved to iCloud drive (or you can choose your own custom location)

Your Start Page is customizable

Pause at 19:50 for discussion

Review options on *Page Menu*

Hide Tool Bar for a larger viewing area. Tap on address the bottom to restore the original view

Show Reader and then tap Summarize

Pause at for discussion at 21:55

Long Press to open a link in a new tab

Long Press on back button to which pages this tab has previously opened

Long Press on + button to see all recently closed tabs

Long Press to create Tab Group

Swipe to Move between the different Tab Groups

Each Tab Group has a Search bar

Pin Tab to the top of the group

Long Press on Tab Group name

You can export your links in a Tab Group to another app such as Notes, in a formatted manner
If your other devices are signed into iCloud, you can view their Tab Groups on your current device
You can share your Tab Group with another user, often a good way to collaborate

Pause at 30:00 for discussion

You can have separate windows open on iPadOS

Long Press Tab Overview button to merge all windows

You can auto close tabs after some period of time, or manually close

Pause at 32:20 for discussion

Bookmarks are more permanent

Long Press on book icon

Use edit button to edit bookmarks

Create a shortcut on your Home screen

Pause at 36:27 for discussion

You can set up different profiles each with different Tab Groups e.g. Work, Personal You can move Tab Groups between different profiles

Pause at 39:38 for discussion

Tap Share and Add to Reading List

Automatically Save Offline if you don't want to be reliant on WiFi or Cellular You can reply inline rather than have to go back to find the original message You can markup images on a website before sharing, save as pdf

Pause at 44:58 for discussion

Enable Autofill
